## Volunteers Safer Recruitment Process:

Are you interested in helping at the club? The club is run by volunteers, and we need your help.

All organisations are now required to undergo a slightly different process. Swim England have outlined this process which we are happy to follow. If you are considering helping out with coaching, you will be encouraged to come along to a few sessions on poolside so finding out what's required by shadowing one of our coaches. If you then think that this is for you, we require you to complete a Volunteer Recruitment form providing references, a DBS check is then required and an on-line Safeguarding Course is to be undertaken. A coaching course or teaching course will then be funded by Northern, with a commitment from you to coach at the club. This is a very rewarding volunteer role.

We don't just need coaches if you have skills in IT or marketing or would like to help out at our open meet by running the raffle, helping out on the door or even training to be one of our timekeepers/officials please contact one of the committee for further information on how you can help your club.

# A Reminder to Parents and Carers

Gentle reminder that parents are not allowed on poolside except in exceptional circumstances.

Also, a recent session had to end early due to illness and there was no parent/responsible adult there to collect your child.

Please remember as a parent/carer you are responsible for your child while they are at the pool. You are responsible for your child if they have a problem such as with their goggles or become ill during the session. We appreciate that on occasion you may not be able to stay at the pool. If this is the case, you must ask another parent to be responsible for your child and let the child and their coach know who is looking after them.

Please also be reminded if you need to speak with the coaches at any please do not come onto the poolside whilst training is in progress. This is due to the safeguarding of our swimmers. Coaches are more than happy to speak with you before training or once training has ended
